

## Washtenaw Regional Resource Management Authority RFP Final Questions and Answers

- 1. Is the service carts-only or carts-plus (residents may put additional bags of waste next to their trash cart)? If cart-plus, are there any volume restrictions?
  - a. Carts-only. There must be a provision for individual service units to obtain more than one cart.
- 2. Can you please confirm the following contract lengths for each participating community? (Pre-Bid Meeting Questions & Answers, Service Questions, 1)
  - a. City of Saline: 60 months Yes
  - b. City of Ypsilanti: 57 months, six days Yes
  - c. Pittsfield Charter Township: 45 months Yes
  - d. Ypsilanti Charter Township: 45 months Yes
- 3. The City of Saline currently has weekly yard waste collection of up to six bags per residence between the first week of April and second week of December. Can you please confirm they want to transition to every-other-week collection? (Pre-Bid Meeting Questions & Answers, Service Questions, 3d)
  - a. Please keep every week Service for Saline
- 4. Does WRRMA have a contract with communities included in this RFP obligating them to proceed with hauler contracts as awarded? In other words, do the participating communities have the ability to opt-out following contract award?
  - a. Under the enabling statute, the authority is allowed to maintain contracts with service providers and with the constituent municipalities (See MCL 123.305 and MCL 123.306) WRRMA will develop and present municipal contracts to each participating municipality. To date, WRRMA has not received any indication from any municipality that it will not enter an agreement.
- 5. Will service frequencies be made available for municipal sites? Knowing how often each container needs to be serviced is critical in determining productivity and pricing.
